

RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE GRADUATION TOWER

§1 General rules and regulations

1.1 The graduation tower is an integral part of “Na Klifie” and the general rules and regulations of the building, as well as the rules and regulations listed below, apply there.

1.2 Prior to using the graduation tower one is obliged to become familiar with these rules and regulations, as well as any contraindications to use the service.

1.3 The purchase of the voucher or the single ticket to the graduation tower is equivalent to the confirmation that the guest has become familiar with these rules and regulations, and undertakes to abide by them, as well as to follow the instructions from the personnel.

1.4 Each person that uses the graduation tower does it on their own responsibility. Prior medical consultation is recommended.

1.5 A recommended single session in the graduation tower should not exceed 30 minutes.

1.6 During a single session the graduation tower can be used by the maximum of 6 persons.

1.7 Children and youth below 18 may use the graduation tower on the responsibility and with the permission of their parents or guardians, and in the care of the adult.

1.8 “Na Klifie” is not responsible for money or personal belongings lost or left on the premises of the graduation tower.

§2 It is strictly forbidden to:

- admit persons, whose condition indicates being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, to the graduation tower,
- let animals in,
- bring one’s own drinks or food,
- bring sharp tools or other dangerous objects,
- make noise that disrupts the relaxing atmosphere,
- interfere in the functioning of the equipment and devices installed,
- pull out or break branches in the graduation tower.

§3 Contraindications:

- inflammation,
- severe diseases resulting in heightened body temperature,
- hyperthyroidism,
- circulatory failure diseases, particularly in patients with low blood pressure,
- recent myocardial infarction,

- tumour,
- advanced bronchial asthma,
- pregnancy or a suspicion of pregnancy,
- hypersensitivity reaction to iodine or bromine.
